A paragraph is a group of related sentences that discuss one (and usually only one) main idea.

The topic sentence states the main idea of the paragraph the specific area to be discussed is called the controlling idea.

A topic sentence is a complete sentence; that is, it contains at least one subject and one verb

Supporting sentences develop the topic sentence That is, they explain or

prove the topic sentence by giving more information about it تعريف اخر للجمل الداعمة:

Supporting sentences explain or prove the topic sentence

The concluding sentence signals the end of the paragraph and leaves the reader with important points to remember:

Unity means that a paragraph discusses one and only one main idea from beginning to end

The Latin verb cohere means "hold together."

Synonyms words that have the same basic meaning. do not always have the same emotional

Some common kinds of logical order in English are:

- 1-Chronological order is order by time—a sequence of events or steps in a process.
- 2- In logical division of ideas, a topic is divided into parts, and each part is discussed separately.
- 3- In a comparison/contrast paragraph, the similarities and/or differences between two or more items are discussed.

Opinions

are subjective statements based on a person's beliefs or attitudes.

Facts are objective statements of truths.

Plagiarism is using someone else's words or ideas as if they were your own

indirect quotations, the speaker's or writer's words are reported indirectly, without quotation marks

An essay

is a piece of writing several paragraphs long. It is about one topic, just as a paragraph is. However, because the topic of an essay is too complex to discuss in one paragraph,

The thesis statement is the most important sentence in the introduction. It states the specific topic of the essay.
