At this semester, a standardized test was given to both groups, and the test results determined the level of academic achievement for the two groups in order to know the relationship between multimedia learning strategies and the development of English language skills while at the same time indicating the effectiveness of multimedia learning.

At the same time, a questionnaire was distributed to a sample of teachers, and a set of interviews was conducted with them. All meetings took place in the school. The responses of the teachers gathered through the questionnaire and interviews were then analyzed and compared with the control group where multimedia learning techniques were not used. Those who participated in the study were compensated with a small gift as a token of appreciation.
