- Focused listing which involves writing down a list of terms and ideas that students connect to a particular topic.

University of Melbourne (2005), states: "other suggested strategies for vocabulary development using active learning techniques can include repetition; using the word in a different way so that a dissimilar meaning is produced; changing the format of the word usage (such as putting it into a different sentence), and discussing the word and its usage with others (this involves production)."




Figure 1. The more words you know, the more you will learn. Retrieved from <u>http://www.worddive.com</u>. Copyright 2013 by Word Dive Blog.
