

ADVERBS | Position of adverbs of frequency in a sentence 1

LEVEL: Intermediate/Advanced

Rewrite each sentence, placing the adverb in brackets in the correct position:

*EX: John listens to me (never) → John **never** listens to me - REMEMBER, make each sentence as "natural-sounding" as possible 😊*

1. John watches scary movies. (*never*)

2. I eat cereal in the morning. (*sometimes*)

3. My team wins. (*never*)

4. My sister is very generous. (*usually*)

5. John is upset. (*always*)

6. He is so annoying! (*sometimes*)

7. I see him. (*rarely*)

8. I have done that. (*never*)
