4	A Valediction: Forbidding Mourning	John Donne	Lyric poem - metaphysical poetry	confident	iambic tetrameter	each four-line stanza is quite unadorned (simple and plain), with an <b>ABAB</b> rhyme scheme .
5	The Passionate Shepherd to his Love	Christopher Marlowe	Pastoral  ( <b>carpe diem</b> )	Happy	iambic tetrameter	these two poems is exact. six stanzas consisting of four lines each .  In each stanza, the <b>first</b> line rhymes with the <b>second</b> , and the <b>third</b> rhymes with the <b>fourth</b> .
